We're coming into our holidays so please watch for all the upcoming events. If you have children coming for the Halloween party - Please sign them up so we have a head count and no child gets left out.

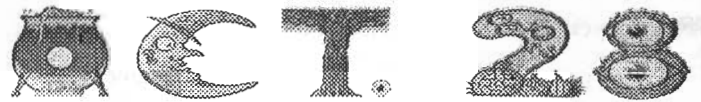

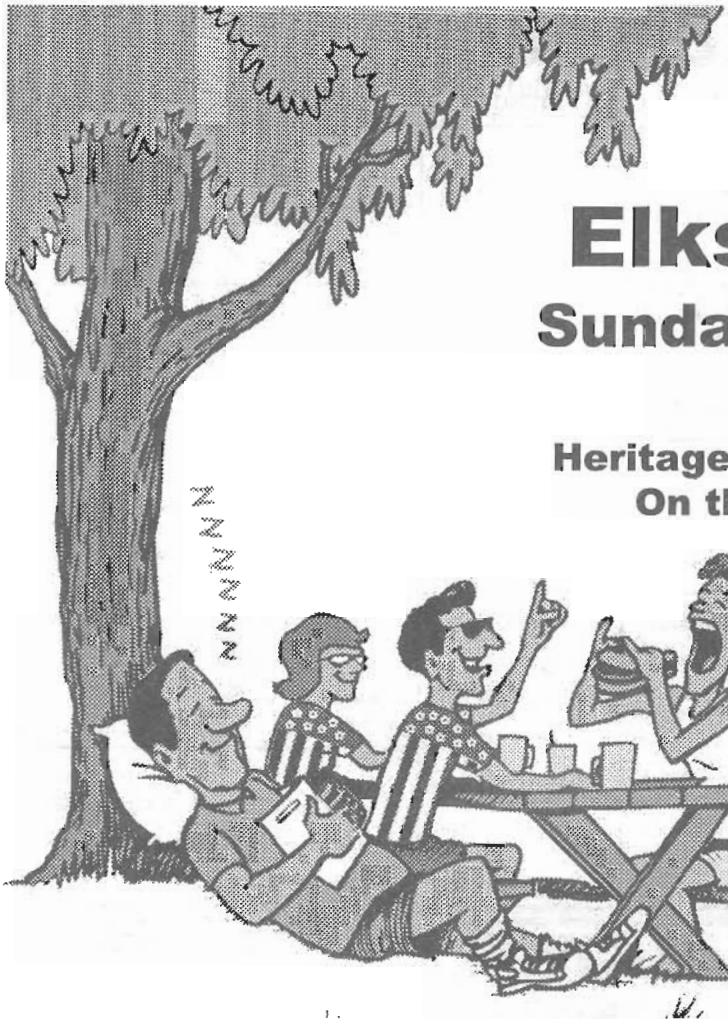

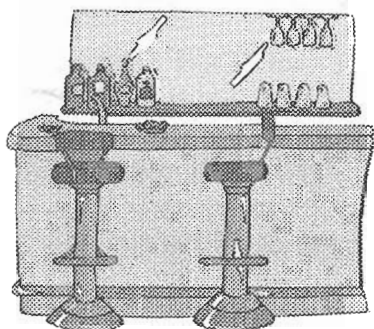
