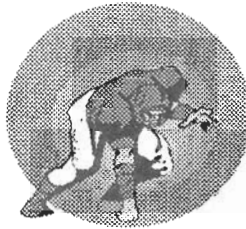

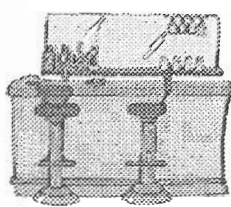
National Service (Veterans) Committee
