

By grand lodge statue our by-laws have to be revised this year. The by-law committee has met and made suggested revisions to our by-laws and house rules. This will serve as notice to all members that the revisions will be voted on by membership on Thursday night, our December 20 meeting.

Please attend this very important meeting so you have a say in laws of our Lodge.

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO BY-LAWS AND HOUSE RULES Article 111

1.Buying Life Membership-Delete \$26.75- Add \$29.00 add 25 times regular dues amount

Article V

Of the secretary: Sec 4. Delete \$6396, add \$7000.

Of the treasurer: Sec.5 Delete \$5396 add \$6000

Of the tiler: Sec.6 Delete \$70 annually, add current annual dues, annually.

Article X

Sec.2 Delete \$58.25 Add \$61.25 In 2008, \$64.25 In 2009, \$67.25 In 2010. Delete "semi-annually, in advance of the first days of April and October in each year, unless member chooses to pay the full years lodge dues " add – all lodge dues hereafter specified shall be payable on or before April 1.

Sec.8 The iniation fee and dues of any applicant who is a member of the armed forces or on active duty and who meets the criteria stated in sec 5 may be remited by a vote of not less than the majority of those present at a regular meeting of the lodge.
