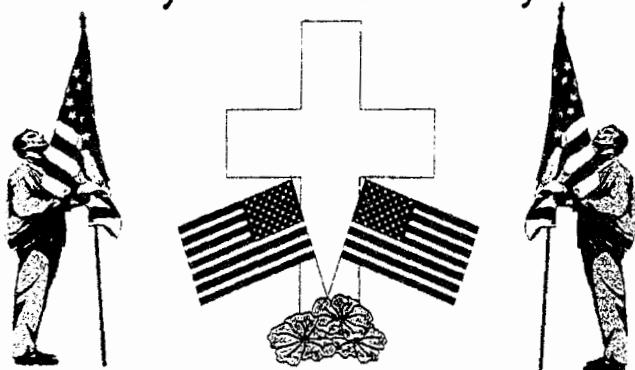

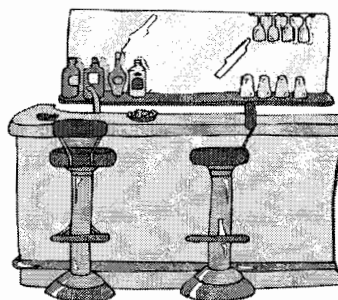

ELKS TRIVIA

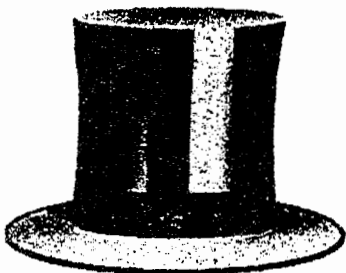
- On May 9, 1961, the Grand Lodge Session created the "Americanism Committee."
- At the Grand Lodge Session of 1946, the word "God" replaced the words "a believer in the existence of a Supreme Being".
- December 1, 1893, the B.P.O.E. banned Sunday meetings on a resolution made at the 1892 Grand Lodge Session by Percy G. Williams of Brooklyn Lodge No.22.
- In 1972 the Veteran's Administration Volunteers Service requested that the Elks start a local, state and national Veterans Arts & Crafts Competition.
- The "Hotel Bedford" now the Elks National Home in Bedford VA, was purchased for 12,500.00 in 1902.
- On May 29, 1969, the Lodge Esquire's instructions on procedures was moved from the end of the initiations ceremony to its present position following the Obligation.
- On June 14, 1949, President Harry S. Truman, a member of the Kansas City, MO lodge no. 26 signed Public Law 203 designating June 14 as Flag Day in America. Flag Day has been a mandatory Lodge activity since 1911.
