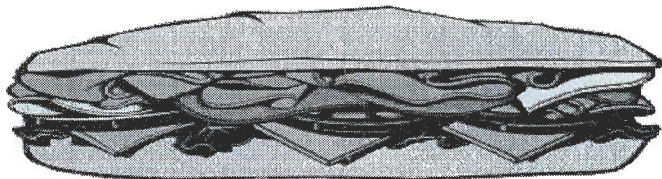

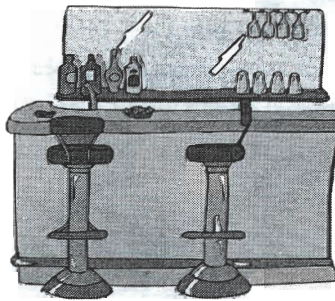

ELK FACTS

Did You Know? The Elks National Foundation annually awards more than 3.4 million in scholarships to a total of 508 students, and an additional 500,000 in emergency educational grants for children of deceased or disabled Elks.

In 2200 communities, men and women of our local Loges are working to meet local needs, whether that's funding the food bank, supplying instruments for the high school band, holding a drug-free prom, or promoting literacy at schools and libraries.

We believe in helping others, but we also believe in having fun. Often we manage to combine the two. Some of our Lodges feature swimming pools, golf courses, playrooms and ball rooms; most have dining facilities; all offer family entertainment. We enjoy doing the good works we do and the people we do them with – our families and our friends.

Last year the Foundation disbursed 12.6 million in support of the "Hoop Shoot®", Scholarships, veterans service drug awareness, state major projects and other philanthropic programs.

The Hoop Shoot® is the largest coeducational sports program in the country. More than three million kids participated in this year's contest.

The Elks have pledged not to forget hospitalized veterans, and each year; they visit hundreds of thousands of patients at VA medical centers and veterans' hospitals, throwing parties and providing companionship. And they invite patients who can leave the facilities to events at Elks Lodges, on fishing trips and to ball games.

The value of Elks' contributions to veteran's service last year was more than 11 million.

In addition to information about drugs, the Elks provide alternatives to drug use by sponsoring activities ranging from Little league to Scouting. More than 2.8 million kids participated in these Elks-sponsored activities last year.
