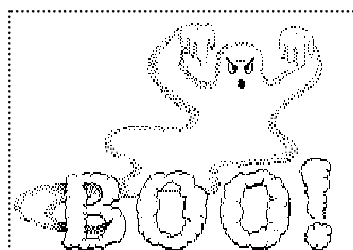

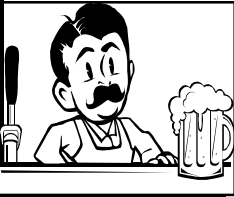

who allows the protester to burn the flag.

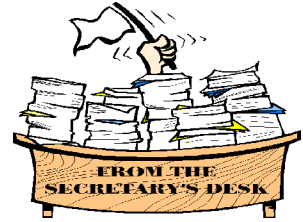
