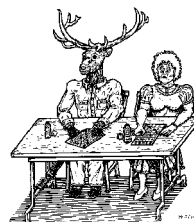

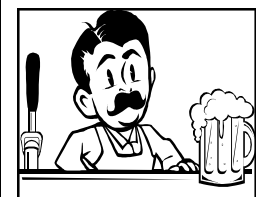

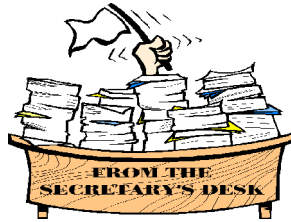

Thank you for the great response to the bulletin dues notice. It shows members are getting AND reading the bulletin and that they want to help us save money.



We had balloting on March 5th and we reinstated Ray Morton, transferred in Barbara Henry PER, Mike Mammarelli, and Larry Huff from #2273. We also approved Douglas Carrigan, Brian Smith and Bernal Lewis PER for life membership. We approved Larry Ulrich and John Stratman for new membership. Congratulations to everyone and welcome to our Lodge.

William Abbey from #2273, David Kennedy from #1468, Andrew Young from #1312 and Dan Harden from #1835 wish to demit to our Lodge. Alton "Buzz" Wood, #2121, wishes to reinstate in the Lodge. David Schmirler is requesting a Certificate of Release from #1288.

The ER and I went to state school in March and in my class for secretary's the State teachers really stressed the loss of memberships in all the lodges. We are dropping 32 members for non-payment and that brings our lodge to fewer than 300 members. We really need to bring guests in and show them what we are about and what we do in the community. If membership keeps declining we will be a thing of the past. It sounds pessimistic but it could happen. They are merging too many lodges as it is now.
