Please don't forget I have spent at least nine years in the Secretary's office and served on house committee and I feel I have a good grasp of how the Lodge runs as a business. 



Chair Officers To assist the ER in the performance of his duties in the order of rank

Trustees Control of the funds, investments and maintaining the property of the Lodge

House Committee or Club Manager of Social quarters & Kitchen Employment of workers, supervision and control of social quarters with the power to suspend a member, fixing of prices and ordering supplies for the Club Facility.

When these governing bodies work together, follow protocol and the statues, by-laws and house rules, Lodges run smoothly.

Members wishing to chair a function, request monies, hire entertainment, file a complaint or make any changes to the building or grounds shall follow proper procedure and address their request to the correct committee in charge, PRIOR to bringing it to the lodge meeting floor for a motion or vote. Not doing this will insure that your request will be tabled at the meeting until the committee is notified. Hollywood West 2365 has abided by this form of governing since 1967, it works and it will be followed in my year as Exalted Ruler.
