Reluctantly, this month I had to drop 28 members for non-payment of dues.

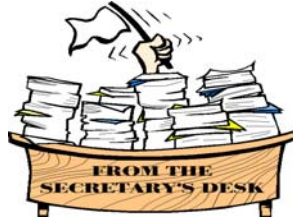
We also lost a brother. PER George Audette, life member of the lodge #799.
