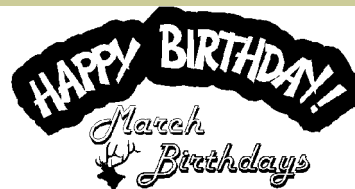

Member David Campbell was approved for life membership to Hollywood West 2365.

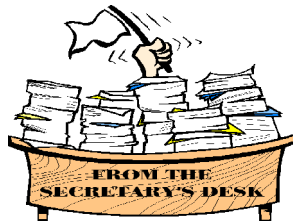
