



### Thank You All.



### State President's Message

### To My Fellow Elks,

As I write this message intended for the **October Lodge Bulletins**, Julia and I will be preparing to travel to the Northwest District for our 6<sup>th</sup> Visitation, and be hosted by the Warrington Lodge 2108. While there our country will have observed the 9<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the tragedy of September 11<sup>th</sup>, 2001. Partly for that reason I think it is appropriate for me to stress my absolute desire and hope that all Florida Elks renew their commitment and pledge to providing whatever support we are able for our Veterans and current military personnel.

Many of our lodge members, including this Elk, served in the Armed Forces. Especially as a Vietnam Veteran, I experienced the low morale fostered by the lack of support for our military deployed in that war. We must not allow that indifference and disdain for the welfare and courage of our soldiers to ever surface again. As Elks we must be aware of the sacrifices many of our current deployed military personnel are experiencing. That factor is why our State Association and a huge number of lodges around the State are rightly focusing on assisting Veterans and active duty personnel with many different charitable activities. Also pause to remember, while a person has the right and privilege to "condemn the war", please do not "condemn the warrior."

The nation's first "Commander in Chief ", George Washington once suggested that the greatness of our country would be partly measured by the extent to which our Veterans were appreciated and treated by their nation. His words then are just as applicable today. Therefore, the Florida Elks stand firm and endorse the assertion, "Because of Veterans past we are free.
