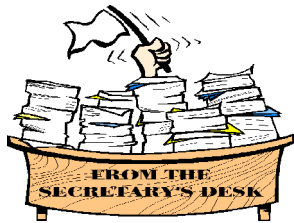

We received a great thank you letter from Glades Middle school in Miramar, and Davie Elementary for all the drug awareness ribbons and literature we gave them for red ribbon week. They were not even aware that the Elks are very serious supporters of drug awareness in schools.

We haven't had many used cell phones come in lately. If you have old ones, please donate them and I will make sure they get to Women In Distress. Unfortunately, there seems to be an increase in domestic violence in these difficult times.
