**Exalted Ruler: Chief Executive Officer of** 

the Lodge

Chair Officers: To assist the ER in the performance of their duties in the order of rank

Control of the funds, investments Trustees: and maintaining the property of the Lodge

House Committee or Club Manager of Social quarters & Kitchen: **Employment of workers**, supervision and control of social quarters with the power to suspend a member, fixing of prices and ordering supplies for the Club Facility.

When these governing bodies work together, follow protocol and the statutes, by-laws and house rules, Lodges run smoothly.

Members wishing to chair a function, request monies, hire entertainment, file a complaint or make any changes to the building or grounds shall follow proper procedure and address their request to the correct committee in charge, PRIOR to bringing it to the lodge meeting floor for a motion or vote. Not doing this will insure that your request will be tabled at the meeting until the committee is notified. Hollywood West 2365 has abided by this form of governing since 1967, it works and it should be followed.
