OFFICIAL DUES NOTICE FOR 2011—2012

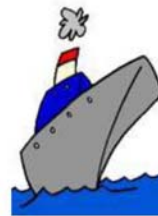

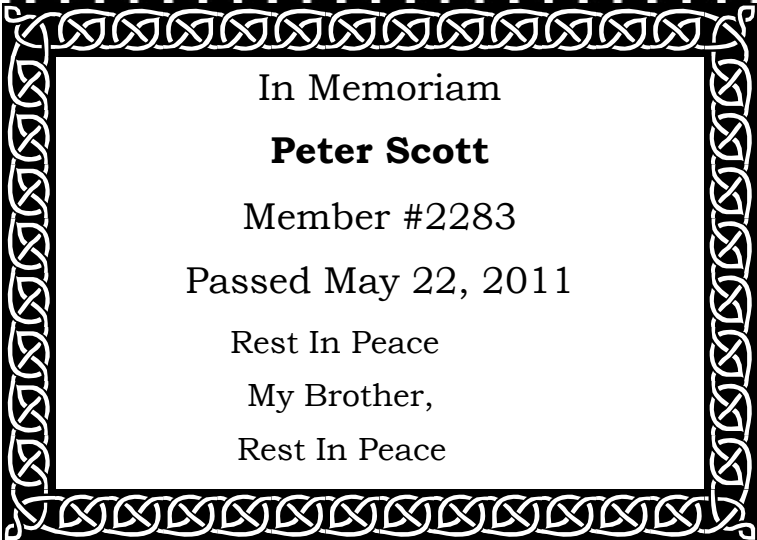

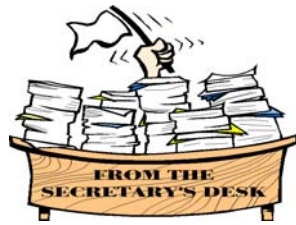

I had a chance to speak to a supervisor and asked what they did with the glasses. He explained they send them somewhere to read the prescription on them and clean them up and they are distributed by volunteers in very poor countries to needy children and adults. He also sent the Lodge a beautiful thank you letter and info on macular degeneration. Don't forget, they can always use audio books and magazines.

Next on the list was Ronald McDonald where we left them with 62 lbs of pop-tops, which they were VERY appreciative of. After that came Women in Distress, we donated children's books, 40 cell phones, 30 batteries and about 25 cases for the phones. We also had 4 bags of women's clothing. We also did a run to Susan B Anthony several times in the last month. We have donated a total of 6 large bags of women's clothes and children's toys along with 4 cases of valentine's candy for handouts. We also donated 2 cases of candy to Davie Elementary for handouts for the teachers.

The men's clothing that is being donated, I am giving to our vet's chairman to distribute, so I haven't been reporting on that.
