RESOLUTION 2011— 27

Proposal to amend Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution:

The above section reads:

Section 18. There shall be no branches or degrees of membership in the Order, nor shall there be other adjuncts or auxiliaries other than Past Exalted Rulers Associations, separate non-profit corporations or charitable trusts, including those previously formed, and the optional organization and maintenance of State Associations except:

A Subordinate Lodge, by appropriate amendment to its by-laws, may recognize a ladies organization(s) as an auxiliary (auxiliaries) to that Lodge, provided its (their) aims and purposes are consistent with those of the Order;

The proposed amendment would read as follows:

Section 18. There shall be no branches or degrees of membership in the Order nor shall there be other adjuncts or auxiliaries other than Past Exalted Rulers Associations, separate non-profit corporations or charitable trusts, including those previously formed, and the optional organization and maintenance of State Associations except:

A Subordinate Lodge, by appropriate amendment to its By-Laws, may recognize a ladies organization(s) as an auxiliary (auxiliaries) to that Lodge, provided its (their) aims and purposes are consistent with those of the Order.

A Subordinate Lodge by appropriate amendment to its by-laws may recognize an organization(s), such as a recreational vehicle group or motorcycle group, provided its {their} aims and purposes are consistent with those of the Order.

(Effective immediately upon receipt of a majority of the votes cast by Subordinate Lodges).

This Resolution is proposed by the Committee on Judiciary.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this Resolution is to permit lodges to recognize other organizations.

COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY:

The Committee on Judiciary finds that the adoption of this Resolution would not violate the Constitution or the Laws of the Order.

To be voted on, at the Lodge, during the September 1st Meeting.

RESOLUTION 2011 - 10

Resolution to amend the Constitution and laws of the Order by replacing the word "Subordinate" with the word "Local" throughout the Constitution and the Laws of the Order, present and prospective:

This Resolution would read as follows:

Resolved, to replace the word "Subordinate" with the word "Local" throughout the Constitution and the Laws of the Order, effective immediately upon receipt of a majority of the votes cast by Subordinate Lodges.

(Effective immediately upon receipt of a majority of the votes cast by Subordinate Lodges).

This Resolution is proposed by the Committee on Judiciary.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this Resolution is to replace the word "Subordinate" with the word "Local" throughout the Constitution and the Laws of the Order.

COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY:

The Committee on Judiciary finds that the adoption of this Resolution would not violate the Constitution or the Laws of the Order.

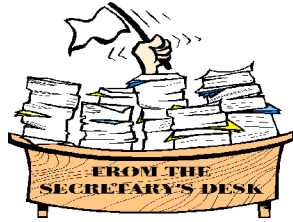
