We need to update our Lodge by-laws.



I am pleased to report that we now have 273 active members and are down to only 29 delinquent! That is quite an achievement! We are welcoming new members and some 'old faithful's' are coming back!

Sharon Bryan, member #2249, is seeking reinstatement into the Lodge.

Please do your best to come out for the September 6th general meeting. At this meeting we will be voting as a Lodge on the proposed Amendment to the Grand Lodge Constitution:

The Resolution is proposed by the Committee on Judiciary

Purpose : To eliminate the position of Grand Treasurer

Committee on Judiciary: The Committee on Judiciary finds that the adoption of this Resolution would not violate the Constitution or the Laws of the Order.

We will also be voting on whether or not to adopt the Ritualistic changes for 2012-2013:

"Delegates to the 148th Grand Lodge Session in Austin, Texas, on July 1 – 5, 2012 were asked to vote on whether to approve a shortened version of the Ritual to open and close regular local Lodge meetings. This proposal follows a 1894 – 1304 vote of delegates at the 2011 Session to amend Section 2.010 of the Grand Lodge Statutes, giving local Lodges the option, through their Bylaws, to use a Grand Lodge approved shortened version."

Right now the Opening of Local Lodge takes 15 minutes. The proposed shortenend version would take 1 minute, 30 seconds. The Closing of Local Lodge now takes 5 and ½ minutes; the shortened version would take 55 seconds. Initiation now

takes 45 to 50 minutes; the shortened version would take 15 to 20 minutes. (I will read the proposed changes at the meeting).

Jill Jacobs, Mary Peterson and Barbara Henry have been busy delivering goods to Susan B. Anthony and Ronald McDonald House. Remember, if you have used clothing – in good condition, consider donating it to the shelter. You can leave your donations with me and they will be delivered to those most in need. Don't forget to save your pop tops too!

It is with much sadness that the Lodge accepted PER Jesse Clemence's resignation from the Board of Directors. Jesse served this Lodge well for many years, and is entitled to a well-deserved 'retirement'. In that same train of thought, we are in need of members willing to step in to help the lodge by running for vacant positions. Please consider the well-being of the lodge. At the first meeting of the month nominations will be heard from the floor to fill these vacancies of 3 Year Trustee and Tiler.

Lastly, I want to convey my thanks and gratitude to all who sent prayers my way during the past few weeks. My niece is at peace now. I would especially like to thank Barbara Henry for taking over my duties for the week that I was back in NJ....she is truly a phenomenal person....
