

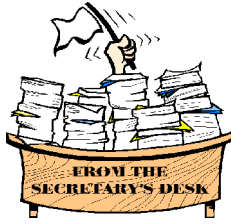


Secretary's Corner
