

### October is ENF Month

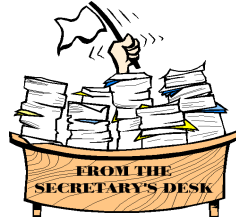
