

October is ENF Month

There is much to celebrate this October as Lodges across Florida show their support of the Elks National Foundation by holding special events to recognize ENF donors and program accomplishments, raise funds, and create excitement about the ENF.

The ENF has contributed more than \$324.6 million toward Elks' charitable projects nationwide.
