# Voting results announced from Tuesday's election

**2014-01** To change the office of Grand Tiler from an elective to an appointed position. **Passed** 2378-507 but requires majority vote by Local Lodges

**2014-02** To allow a Lodge in Texas to become a member of the New Mexico Elks Association with the concurrence of the Sponsors of both states. **Passed** 2543-340 but requires majority vote by Local Lodges

2014-03 To authorize a Lodge to require its officers to memorize the Opening, Closing and Initiatory rituals under penalty of removal from office. Failed 1000-1882

**2014-04** To authorize a Lodge through a By-Law provision to impose an annual assessment on its members to be applied toward the use of specified club facilities. **Failed** 1045-1835

**2014-05** To authorize a Lodge through a By-Law provision to impose assessment on its members to be applied toward the use of specified club facilities. **Failed** 1050-1828

**2014-06** To reinstate the Grand Lodge and Local Lodge Public Relations Committees. 2122-764 **Passed** 

**2014-07** To limit the authority of an Exalted Ruler who is the subject of a club suspension proceeding. 2408-473 **Passed** 

**2014-08** To allow a Local Lodge Mediator to hear from witnesses during mediation sessions. 2142-742 **Passed** 

**2014-09** To eliminate the Grand Lodge Government Relations Committee and reassign its duties to the Activities Committee. 609-2267 **Failed** 

2014-10 To change the office of Lodge Tiler from an elective position to an appointed position. 2240-639 Passed

2014-11 To define "Restricted Funds" under the Laws of the Order. 2451-424 Passed

**2014-12** To limit a Lodge's ability to disburse or borrow against Restricted Funds in a manner which is contrary to the restricted purpose. 2273-607 **Passed** 

**2014-13** To allow the governing body of the Home, Club or other facility to suspend or revoke club privileges of a visiting Member without the requirement of a club suspension hearing 1410-1475 **Failed** 

**2014-14** To clarify the time frames within which action is to be taken by a Presiding Justice as part of a Local Forum proceeding. 2683-193 **Passed** 

**2014-15** To allow a vote to be taken by secret ballot instead of the voting sign of an Elk by a majority vote of the Lodge. 2161-720 **Passed** 

**2014-16** To facilitate the timely collection of membership statistics by the Grand Secretary's Office, leaving the process of charity reporting and dues payment unchanged. 2440-428 **Passed** 

**2014-17** To increase the number of officers who may serve as alternate check signers and the amount of any authorized Club supplies account.1683-1194 **Passed** 

2014-8 To amend and clarify the procedure to drop a Member from the Lodge membership rolls for indebtedness to the Lodge. 2580-297 0. Passed

**2014-19** To authorize the appointment of multiple Presiding Justices and/ or Mediators as needed. 1879-998 **Passed** 

**2014-20** To allow a Lodge to hold regular Lodge meetings monthly, semimonthly, trimonthly or weekly as provided by approved Lodge By-laws. 1326-1495 **Failed** 

**2014-21** To revise the timetable of nominations for Officers in the event resolution 2014-20 is confirmed. 1454-1349 Resolutions 2014-21 and 2014-22 are dependent upon the approval of Resolution 2014-20. Resolution 20 failed so Resolution 21 likewise **Failed**.

**2014-22** To revise the annual election of Officers in the event resolution 2014-20 is confirmed. 1427-1351 Resolutions 2014-21 and 2014-22 are dependent upon the approval of Resolution 2014-20. Resolution 20 failed so Resolution 22 likewise **Failed**.




