We made it thru December and starting a new year. I hope that everyone had a happy holiday season. Now it is time to get our heads together and have all officers step up and get ready for our new Elks year.

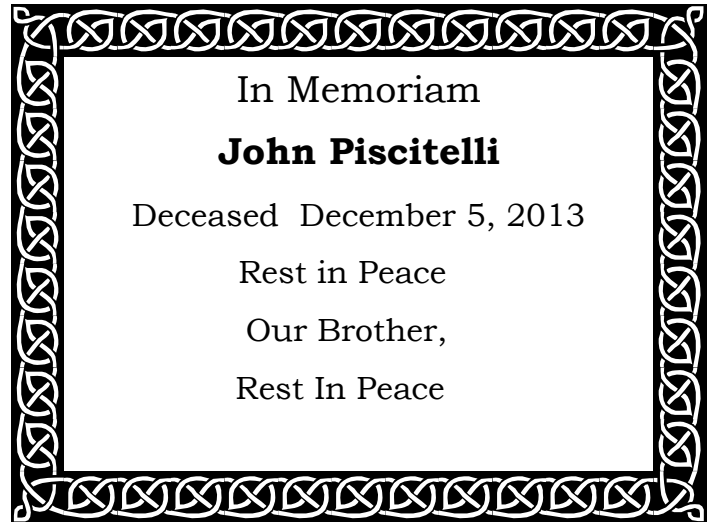


