

are looking in to the possibility of the inside be available. This could generate more income for our Lodge. We continue to need more help. Thanks to the members that came out to help us in June.

No one has come to our E.R. John Musser with a suggestion of someone from our Lodge to go on "Honor Flight" scheduled for October 11, 2014.

We need donations from our members and friends to send a WWII Veteran from our Lodge on the Honor Flight to Washington, DC. To learn more about Honor Flight go to HonorFlightSouthFl.org. This is a full day beginning at 5AM and returning approximately 8:30PM to Fort Lauderdale Airport. The Veteran will have an assistant with him/her at all times. The Veteran will get to see WWII Memorial, The Korean Memorial, The Vietnam Reflecting Wall and several other sights. The last flight on May 31, there was approximately 4000 people in terminal 3 at the airport that welcomed 46 Vets back.

If we raise enough funds we might be able to send more Veterans from our Lodge. This would be a wonderful event for this Lodge, because it has never been done before. (Elks Support Veterans)

The cost is \$400.00 per Veteran. Time is running out, there are about 800 WWII Veterans dying every day. Let us show them our appreciation and that we care by sending them on the Honor Flight
