This has been an exciting year. By the time you receive this newsletter our new officers have been elected. Come in on Sunday, March 23, for the Installation of Officers at 4pm







It was my pleasure to serve as the Harry-Anna, Government and Public Relations chairperson this year. I am proud to say that the lodge helped out the following organizations:

- 1. Ft. Lauderdale Ronald McDonald House received approximately 350 thousand pop tabs, over 100 magazines and books along with 100 volunteer hours.
- 2. William "Bill" Kling outpatient VA in Sunrise was happy to receive over 700 books and magazines, 100 military ball caps, 75 quilted lap blankets and wheel chair bags, and dozens of volunteer hours.
- 3. The Alexander Sandy Ninninger State Veterans Nursing Home in Pembroke Pines was thrilled with gifts and monthly visits to the 120 residents. The Veterans committee volunteered 100's of hours, along with holding a monthly flea market to raise money and purchased a large display case, hundreds of holiday cards, cakes and snacks. They also provided a free brunch to the Veterans at our lodge each month.
- 4. Broward County Lighthouse for the Blind was thrilled to received 60 pair of eye glasses and 23 eye glass cases to help out the less fortunate.
- 5. Susan B. Anthony women's center in Pembroke Pines was pleased to receive bags of newer clothing and cases of food.
- 6. Goodwill received approximately 300 books.
- 7. Davie Elementary School was happy to receive hundreds of pencils, folders and reams of notebook paper.
- 8. Harry-Anna has received approximately \$1,500.00 from flea market sales, donations for gift bags, 50/50, Chinese auction, snack sales, Pennies from Heaven and other donations.
- 9. An orphanage in Columbia, South America was over whelmed in receiving approximately \$400.00 of toys and other items sent by two of our members. Also, two of our other members received a "Florida Governor Service Award" while another received a "Volunteer of the year Award".

The lodge also held fundraisers to help out some of our members and families.

I appreciate every members help and support throughout the year.
