The Veteran's Committee

The year (2014) is over. It has been a good year for the Veteran's Committee. We have had 12 successful brunches, 9 successful flea markets, parties at the Sandy Nininger's South



Florida Veterans Nursing Home and distributed much needed dothing, toiletries, playing cards, board games, holiday cakes and most of all company and support for all of the Veterans.

In October, our Exalted Ruler, John Musser, started a new program at the Veteran's Nursing Home. On the second Friday of every month, the Nursing Home has a Memorial Service for the families of Veterans that have passed in the prior 6 weeks. At this service, we fold the United States Flag (thirteen folds) and inform everyone the meaning of each fold. It is presented to the family of the oldest deceased Veteran in the prior 6 weeks. The other families receive a pre-folded flag. There is an average of six Veterans passing each month.

The December Flea Market was very successful. The Veteran's Committee will donate some of its profits to the roof repair fund. Our next flea market is January 3, 2015.

On December 18, 2014, our Lodge #2365 members donated over \$300.00 in toys to the Susan B. Anthony Woman and Children's Home in Pembroke Pines. The facility is home for 40 women and approximately 50 children that range from newborn to 13 years of age. Most of the women are recovering alcoholics, recovering drug addicts, or homeless. It was such a pleasure to deliver the toys to the children.

On December 19, 2014, our Lodge #2365 presented a plaque to Oscar Correale, Director of Recreation at the Sandy Nininger's Nursing Home. He is retiring December 31, 2014. He is the connection for our Lodge to the Nursing home.

On December 23, 2014, the Veteran's Committee hosted a Christmas Holiday Party for the Veteran's at the Sandy Nininger's Nursing Home. There were 60 Veteran's and 38 family members. The Veteran's Committee distributed holiday cards, solar-activated Santa Claus', Elf's, Dancing Girls, Flowers, Socks, Toothbrushes, Toothpaste, under shirts, Elk's shirts, hats, and miscellaneous items.
