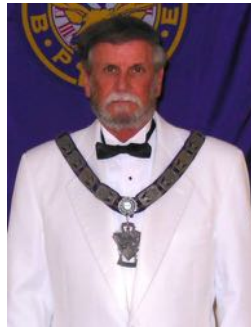

Florida Elks,

"Blast Elkdom into the Future"

Hello Florida Elks! We are almost to the end of the first month of this Elk year and so far it's been exciting! Your state Harry-Anna chairman, Dave Manning, reports that we are having a good year starting out. Dave has some great ideas to increase donations to the trust fund which I will talk about in my next article.



This month I want to talk about our Charity Book. Every Lodge has one and the DD's are supposed to check the entries.

Angel used to donate cakes to our Lodge for an event. My question is this: Does anyone know how much you can put down in your Charity Book for the donation of the cake? Free...\$5...\$10...\$30...?

Well here goes. Let's say that you start at 8:00 am and drive to Publix and purchase the ingredients for \$5.50. The round trip distance from your house to the store is 4 miles. You then use the ingredients, mix them up, and put them in the oven to bake. After baking, you let the cake cool. You ice the cake. Then you lick the spoon. The time that you traveled to Publix, mixed the ingredients, baked and iced the cake is 4 hours. You take the cake to the Lodge and everyone enjoys your delicious creation. The Lodge is a round trip of 20 miles and it takes you a total of 20 minutes to drive it.

Now, let's add everything up:

Cost	\$ 5.50	
Miles	\$ 12.96	24 miles @ .54 per mile (2016 IRS rate)
Time	<u>\$103.04</u>	4 hours/40 minutes @ \$22.08 per hour
	\$121.50	Charity Book Total

As members we do a lot of volunteering. What we don't do is document it. Do you know what our donations would be if everyone started to write things down? For example, consider members volunteering in the kitchen or serving. Do you add the time traveled and the mileage? Something to think about.

If you have any good ideas (and I know that you do), I would like to hear about them. If you share your good ideas every District will become better.

Remember, your ideas will Blast Elkdom into the Future.

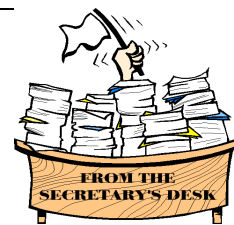
