Special thanks to John Musser our ,PER , for the new door in the kitchen and for his financial contributions.

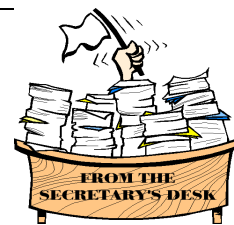
