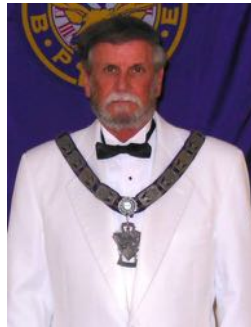
### Exalted Rulers Message

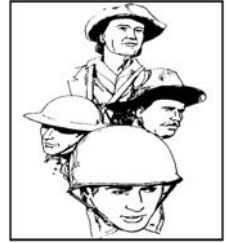

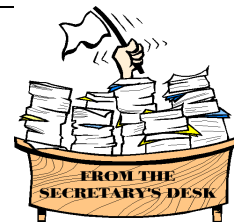
