

State President's Message

Hello Florida Elks,

"Blast Elkdom into the Future"

Hello Florida Elks! We are almost half way through this fraternal year and our visitations have totaled eight. We have also travelled to Houston for the National Convention, attended the great FLOE



Conference in Clearwater and had one adventure to the Youth Camp for our advisory council meeting. This year has been tremendous and memorable for Carl, Cathy and myself. In the first five months we have been exposed to quite a few new ideas in the arena of membership, the Florida Elks Charitable Trust Fund and charity donations. What I will do in this issue, is to review what we have come up with.

Membership: Our State Chairman, Suzi Simonelli, and our State Vice Chairman, Rod O'Conner, are doing a fantastic job. By the latest statistics we show new members and reinstatements with a plus of 2,884 to our goal of 5,590. Our lapsation sits at 6,572 with a goal of 2,795. We have two different membership programs. The first is for the Lodges and Districts. \$20,000 will be awarded on membership percentages by the state organization. You can view the membership awards on our website. The second awards our members. The member awards are by Magic Numbers in your Lodge. There are five levels and 3 prizes in each level ranging from \$50 to \$1,000. If a member gets five new members or reinstatements, they will receive a Moon Buggy membership pin.

Florida Elks Charitable Trust Fund: We have several programs to donate to for our Major Project Trust Fund.

The first is the State Presidents Harry-Anna Pin. A donation of \$50 will get you one Space Station Pin. Next we have the "Donate" button on the top right side of our Florida Elks website. You can set up a one-time gift or have your gift come out automatically each month.

Next we have the \$100 "C" Certificate for an initial donation of \$20, then each year for four years. The donation is made and you will get a yearly announcement that your \$20 donation is due. We have quite a few Lodges that pay the first assessment of the "C" certificate. We would like all lodges to try to do this. Last year we had 3,400 and change of new certificates. We had over 7,000 new members. If each lodge paid the first assessment, we would have over \$140,000 in new money. We also need to tell the new members that the Lodge is doing this and they will get the notice next year. You can't get everyone to pay because some say that they did not know about this or simply don't want to do it. This is where the Lodge MUST tell them and makes them aware. If 1,000 did not pay, that still would be \$120,000 in assessments the second year plus another \$120,000 in new members this year which would total \$240,000 in new money the second year. There are also two other programs that if you purchase something on-line, through either website, a percentage will be donated to the Harry-Anna Trust, Youth Camp, or Therapy Services. These are Smile.Amazon.com and Give.com.

Charity Donations: Every Lodge needs volunteers. We need to have our dedicated volunteers write their information down so we as an organization can get credit for it and to keep our charitable status. An example would be: If you bake a cake and donate it to the Lodge, how much should you write down? In my July presidents message I gave the example of writing down \$121.50 for your charitable donation of a cake. See that article below to get the details. As members we do a lot of volunteering. We just need to document your involvement. This also goes for anything you volunteer for, not just baking a cake.

We have great Lodges and Great members! We need to work together as a team and build each lodge to the highest level.

As always, if you have any good ideas, please let me know! We have other ideas that will come out in next month's message.

Thanks again for all of your help. Remember, your ideas will "Blast Elkdom into the Future".
