Paul Houser and myself represented the lodge at Florida Elks Mid-Year Convention. We learned several new things that will help our lodge.

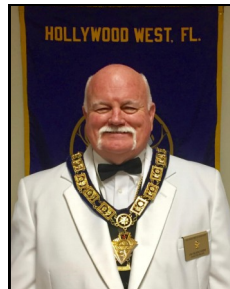

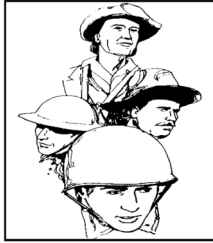

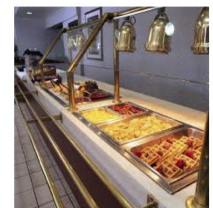
