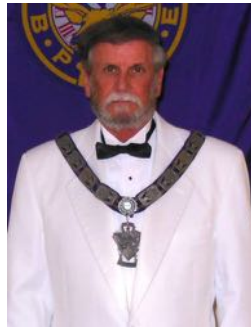

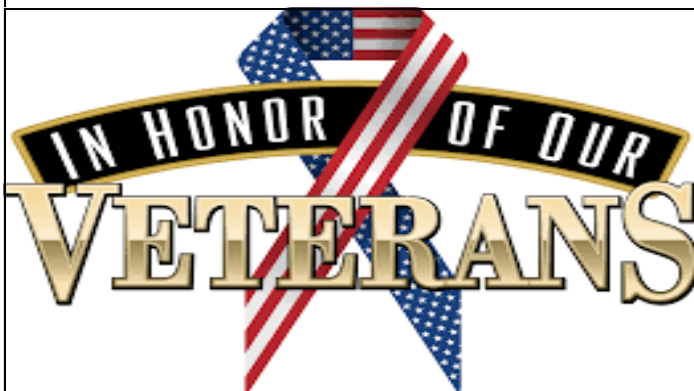

State President's Message

Hello Florida Elks,

"Blast Elkdom into the Future"

Hello Florida Elks! We have just about finished November 2016. We had an exceptional Midyear Convention at the Lake Mary Marriott and were pleased to congratulate our Endorsed State President, Carl Gerace and Cathy, along with our Endorsed Vice President at Large, Frank Malatesta and Sally. They both will do a fabulous job next year.



November was for giving thanks as it was Veterans Remembrance Month. In our travels we witnessed some great adventures with our veterans. When visiting Brandon, we toured the Liberty Manor for veterans. Connie and David Lindsey and the Brandon Lodge have gone out of their way for our veterans at the home. At our visit to St. Petersburg, we visited the C.W. Bill Young Medical Center (Bay Pines VA Hospital). Simply a great hospital for our veterans.

I hope all Elks had a great Thanksgiving holiday visiting friends and family. We look forward to having another great holiday season with Christmas fast approaching followed with our New Year's Eve party at our great youth camp. You can find information about the NYE party on the homepage of this website.

Ok, we are down to "What do I want to talk about this month."

As most of you know I do a lot of visiting. VP Saturday night parties, DD Visitations, State President's visits and just plain visiting which I have been doing consistently since 1990. As most of you know, we have some Lodges in financial difficulty. I was at one of the DD Visitations (not in my district) listening to the DD asking the Board of Directors and House Committee the following question: "What is the function of the House Committee?" The answer was to make money. Then he asked, "Does the BOD or House Committee look at the profit and loss statement or the cost of goods?" The answer was "Yes we do." In my mind, I think the question should have been: "How many House Committee members actually get a monthly report?" I normally don't ask questions, just listen. But something occurred to me and I asked this question: "How many members on the BOD and House Committee actually know how to read a profit and loss statement?"

The answer was not shocking, only about two on each committee. I'm certainly not a financial wizard, but when someone hands me a one page profit and loss statement and I cannot tell which department is making or losing money, then that's a problem. I then asked: "What is the cost per plate in the kitchen? What is the cost per drink in the bar?" No one knew. My feeling is that you need a DETAILED "Final Report" for each function in your Lodge which should include the cost per plate including salt, pepper, plastic, spices, bread, butter, etc. How many Lodges do this?

What I usually hear is that the Lodge made \$800 last Saturday. But they don't realize they spent \$900 to get the \$800! How many Lodges do an inventory of their bar at least monthly? Do they break it down by cost of drink? The bottom line is that we are a business and to stay in business we need to take a different and more detailed approach. We need to find a way to educate our great volunteers serving on our BOD and House Committees to give them the know-how to be able to read a profit and loss statement. Detailed reports will give you a lot of information and provide you with monthly trends in a particular area which can be very useful.

Maybe we need to have a district meeting with all Lodges participating in how to analyze a P&L statement and how decipher a detailed report. Many years ago we combined two districts and held just such a meeting. All but one lodge in both districts participated. Some of the comments were, "I didn't know about that."

We have great Lodges and great members and we need to work together as a team and build each lodge to the highest level. As always, if you have any good ideas, please let me know. I have other ideas that will be addressed in next month's message. Stay tuned!

Thanks again for all of your help. Remember, your ideas will "Blast Elkdom into the Future."
