The Veteran's Committee

Greetings to all,

May completes our Flea Markets for the beginning of the year. Our next Flea Market will be in October in time to start your Holiday Shopping. We had a very successful fund raising to support all of our Veterans projects. We are expanding our Veterans projects by purchasing items to help train dogs to assist our wounded Veterans. The dogs are being trained at a prison in Martin County by the prisoners, a two fold purpose, to help a prisoner get back into society and to help a Veteran to live a life that he or she may not have been able to live without some assistance.



The Veterans have also donated clothing to the women of Susan B. Anthony Home for Rehabilitation in Pembroke Pines, and toys for the children that live there with their Mothers. This past Holiday season in December, the Elks Veterans Committee gave a present to 52 children ranging from ages 0-9 years old.

The Veterans from Sandy Nininger South Florida Veterans Nursing Home were at the Lodge in May. There were 6 Veterans and 2 Aids present. They really look forward to being there. One of the Veterans at the Nursing Home made a donation of \$300.00 to the Veterans Committee for the support of the Veterans.

Our Annual "Wreaths Across America" drive will start July 1st, 2017. All Across America, people place a Holiday Wreath on every grave of every Veteran in every National Cemetery. We will be mailing out applications to order a wreath or as many as you select, to be placed on a grave site in the National Cemetery in Lake Worth Florida on December 16, 2017 at 11AM. The cost of a wreath is \$15.00. We have several members of our Lodge that attend this event and help place the wreaths on the graves. All military services are represented. Last year we sold 60 wreaths. This year our goal is 150 wreaths. Please help us reach our goal, as we never forget our Veterans, they are why we are Free today. We would appreciate you returning your request for a wreath or wreaths by November 1, 2017.

Our Charity Auction is right around the corner, June 4, 2017. Come out and have a great time and keep cool on a Sunday afternoon 2PM - 6PM. We have 20 vendors lined up, food, and a great time for all. Tell your family, neighbors, and friends how much fun it is.
