The Holidays are fast approaching and the lodge will be busier than ever. Be on the look out for your annual Dinty Moore fundraiser dinner tickets in the mail.

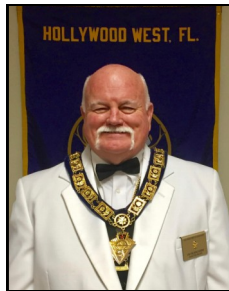

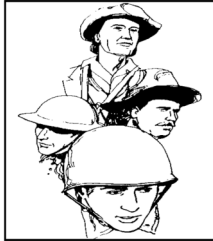

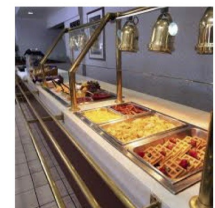
