

### The Veteran's Committee

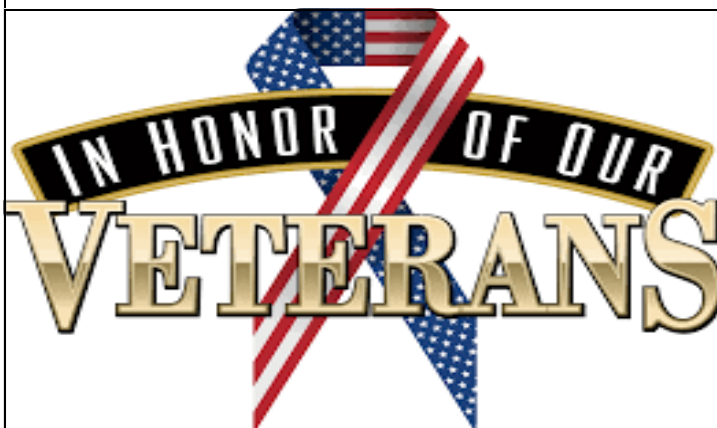
