



May18 was Armed Forces Day, the day to Honor all the Military Services of our Country. The Veterans from Sandy Nininger South Florida Veterans Nursing Home were at




the Lodge for Brunch on the 3rd Sunday of the month. Thanks to all that took the time to thank them for their Service. They were so glad to talk to everyone.

The Veteran's Committee paid for a Guardian on the May flight to Washington D.C. with Honor Flight. We are looking for someone to go on the June 8th flight, as a Guardian. It was a long day but so exciting you will never forget it. It starts Saturday 4am when you pick up your Veteran to go to the FLL Airport. You spend the whole day visiting all the Monuments. You depart D.C. about 6pm and arrive at FLL 8:30pm. There are about 1500 people waiting to welcome home the Veterans from a day they will never forget. Honor Flight South Florida.org. sponsors the trip and we fly Spirit Airlines which has donated the plane and their staff for 4 flights in 2019, at no cost to Honor Flight. It flies WW2, Korea and Vietnam Veterans FREE to visit the monuments dedicated to their Service.

On May 24, the Veteran's Committee helped the City of Hollywood Florida put on a Memorial event. The Committee provided battery operated candles for the adults and glow sticks for all of the children, for a candlelight service. There were about 500 people in

attendance and our own Lodge member Tony Gomez played Taps for the event. Keep June 8th (Saturday night) open to be present at the Homecoming of our Veterans in Terminal 4 (Spirit Airlines). Be one of the Americans that welcome home our Heroes.


