Keep checking your email for upcoming events.

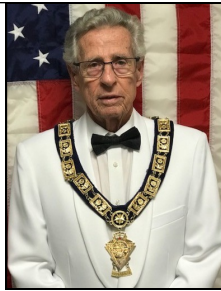
I am choosing Gina Albright as Officer of the Month. Gina has helped at our Brunch and at the 4th of July BBQ. Gina is always willing to help out where she can.
