The camp offers a challenge ropes course and climbing wall. Each of our 52 airconditioned camper cabins have full bathrooms and are assigned a counselor and an assistant counselor. Our second major project is Florida Elks Children's Therapy Services. We are helping families with children in need develop and grow by offering free in-home therapy services to more than 500 children a week. Our therapists treat children using physical and occupational therapy on most every childhood disability including autism spectrum disorder.
