Bingo is back and doing great with more of our players returning.

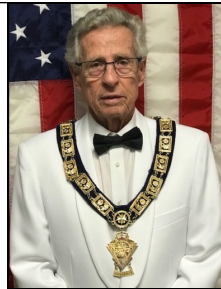

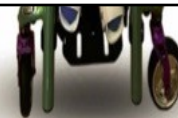

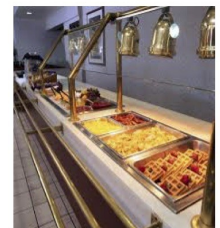
